



CAREER PATHWAYS BRIDGE PROGRAM

Jumpstart your academic and professional career with a full associate degree scholarship, plus free meal plans, transportation, and emergency funding from the NYU SPS Division of Applied Undergraduate Studies (DAUS). The Career Pathways Bridge Program is geared towards recent New York public high school graduates who have not yet earned a college degree. Applicants must be residents of the State of New York and live within commuting distance of NYU. Students who have completed a year or less at another institution, yet have not earned their degree from that institution, and wish to transfer to NYU SPS, are welcome to apply.



The NYU SPS Office of Admissions carefully weighs each component of your application during a personalized review process.

GENERAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Degree Requirements
 - · Completion of a US high school diploma, GED or equivalent
 - Applicants must have at least one academic semester after high school graduation to apply
- Resume
- Statement of Purpose
- Transcripts from all institutions attended
- Letters of Recommendation: one (optional)
- English Language Assessment: (International Applicants)
 - TOEFL or IELTS: *May be eligible for a waiver

FINANCIAL AID

Whether you are a transfer student or going back to school after a break, you may qualify for grants, loans, and scholarships. Associate degrees have a lower per credit tuition. New York residents may be able to attend tuition free if they are eligible for TItle IV (Pell) or NY State TAP.
